How to apply for special examination based on university recommendation

1. Please kindly inform your students of our special examination based on university recommendation.
2. If there are students who want to apply for this examination, please have them contact us (hge@hosei.ac.jp) with their educational background and the field of study that they are interested in.

We will schedule a time for your students to contact with supervisors in Hosei University whose research fields may match his/her educational background and interest.

Please note that your students will be required to discuss his/her research project with the supervisors and obtain their approval prior to the application period in order to avoid any mismatch between student's research interest and supervisor's research area. After their discussions are completed, we will inform the students whether they are approved for application or not directly.

3. We will make a list of students who are approved for application and send it to you. Please have the students submit the application documents following the application guidelines accordingly.

Note: If there are two or more students who are approved for application in your university, we will inform you how to deal with this.
